- ☐ other proof or authorisation if you have applied for an advance import licence for removal goods or an import licence for any weapons if you have them among your removal goods

Attachments are needed to process the declaration.

If you bring the goods in yourself, present them along with the completed form to a customs official at the nearest open customs office. Otherwise, send the declaration and its attachments primarily by secure email to lomaketullaus@tulli.fi.
