Narcotics Seized in Finland

Within the framework of the current investigation, a significant amount of narcotics has been seized in Finland. The seizures include the following:

- Alpha-PVP 12,1 kilograms, of which Customs seized 10 kilograms and the Police 2,1 kilograms (equivalent to approximately 97 kilograms of amphetamine)
- amphetamine 2 kilograms, MDMA 3 kilograms, ecstasy 4 430 tablets, marijuana 5 kilograms, hashish 1 kilogram, controlled medicines 5 290 units and cash 31 700 euros.

The total street value of the seized narcotics is estimated at approximately 3.4 million euros.

During the investigation, three firearms were also confiscated

Narcotics Distributed in Finland During the Period Autumn 2023–2025

According to the preliminary investigation, the suspects distributed the following quantities of narcotics in Finland during the period from autumn 2023 to 2025:

- Alpha-PVP 195,9 kilograms
- Cocaine 38,9 kilograms
- Amphetamine 67,1 kilograms
- MDMA/Ecstasy 53,4 kilograms
- Ecstasy tablets 3 873 units
- Marijuana/Hashish 171 kilograms
- Oxycontin 331 units
- KKP substance 30,6 kilograms
- Subutex 685 units
- Ketamine 1,5 kilograms (not classified as a narcotic)

The estimated wholesale resale value of these substances exceeds €15 million, and the total street value is estimated at over 40 million euros. Examples of Estimated Sales Values:

Import-level price Alfa-PVP: 736 million euros (40€/g)

Street-level price: 31,344 million euros (160€/g)
