**3 Purpose of the processing of personal data / Purpose of the register**

The data will be used to deliver statistical publications on the international trade in goods by Finnish Customs. The register is based on subscriptions made through the tull.fi website. Persons included in the register will be sent a link to the statistical publication in Finnish and/or Swedish and/or English, according to the type of subscription. If necessary, the information will be used for the fall-back procedure for delivery (delivery by email), for the delivery of information concerning the subscription as well as for customer surveys.

**4 Data content of the register**

Email address of the subscriber.

**5 Data sources of the register**

The data stored in the register is obtained from the subscription forms submitted by subscribers to the statistical publications on international trade in goods.

**6 Disclosure of data and transfer of data outside the EA or the EEA**

Data stored in the register will not be disclosed for other purposes outside Finnish Customs Statistics, and data will not be transferred outside the EU or the EEA.

**7 Register protection principles**

The register is completely electronic and is located in a supervised server centre on a server protected with user login credentials. Finnish Customs and the provider of the register service will, to the best of their abilities, ensure that information security is maintained.

## **8 Right of inspection**

For example:

As a rule, a member registered in the register has a right to inspect the information stored on him/her in the personal data register and request that the controller correct any incorrect information. The request for inspection must be submitted in writing to the controller in question.

## **9 Correction of data in the register**

For example:

The controller must, without undue delay, either on the controller's own initiative or at the request of the registered person, correct, remove or complete personal data in the register that is, for the purposes of processing the data, either needless, insufficient or obsolete.
